CCOE released the 2019 study in March with a stakeholder forum featuring Mayor Kevin Faulconer; keynote by Dr. John Zangardi, Chief Information Officer for the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; EDC study highlights and an engaging panel starring leaders from the City of San Diego, Sentek, NAVWAR, Teradata and USD. And the news is good...the region is now home to more than 150 cyber firms and 8,450 cyber professionals that generate an annual economic impact of \$2.2 billion (16% increase since the 2016 study!).
